JUNE 24 - ANNUAL TYLER PARK PICNIC

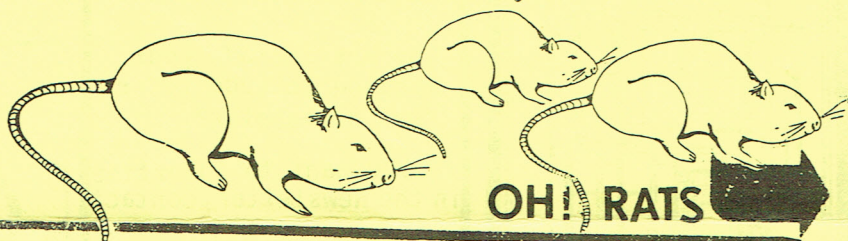

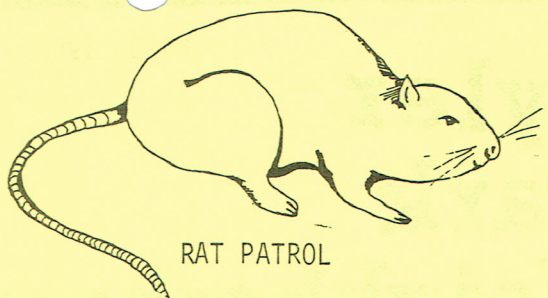
••• Parking on Bardstown Road •••

The City of Louisville has worked out a unique arrangement in an effort to provide additional parking on Bardstown Road. Meters will be installed on the lot next to Precision Tune at Eastern Parkway and Bardstown Road for day time use. At night, the lot will be leased to the Uptown to provide parking for its patrons. This joint arrangement is a first, and if it's successful, the City may consider other similar arrangements. So remember, there will be off-street parking during the day at Bardstown Road and Eastern Parkway.

RAT PATROL

Federal and county monies are no longer available for rat control leaving only city funding. Thus it is very important that we all take precautions.

FACTS YOU SHOULD KNOW

- Rats have an average of 7 offspring per litter.
- Offspring can reproduce in 4 months.
- A rat produces an average of 7 litters per year.
- A rat only needs 1 ounce of food a day to survive.
- Rats love dog food and can survive on dog feces.

THINGS YOU CAN DO

- Store your garbage in plastic bags and then in metal containers. Place plastic bags out on morning of pickup. This way, the rats cannot get to the garbage, and the garbage men cannot get to the containers.
- Remove all weeds and junk from the alleys and yard. Property owners are responsible to the center of the alley.

- Store firewood, etc. 18 inches above ground. Anything on the ground is a temptation for rats.

This coming junk pickup could make a difference. Let's clean up our yards and alleys and do our part to prevent rats.

If you see a rat, call Rodent Control, 587-3875; give the exact location. The agency will help rid us of rats if we help them with information.

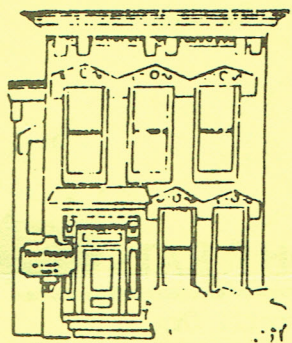

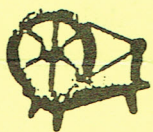

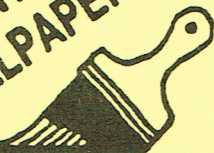
