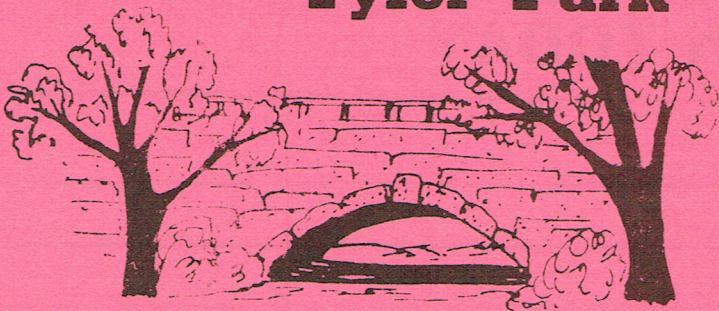

Trees

YOU MAY BE ELIGIBLE FOR A FREE 3 INCH HARDWOOD TREE

You may be eligible for a free 3 inch hardwood tree.

TPNA is working with Third Ward Alderman, Mike Carrell, and the Metropolitan Park Department to add trees to the park and the neighborhood. The Board of Aldermen have authorized funds to replant trees on Eastern Parkway from Cherokee Park to Preston Street and for planting and replacing trees in parks and public rights of way. The TPNA board has requested appropriations for 38 trees. Of these 7 or 8 will be planted in the Park to replace those lost in recent storms. The remaining trees will be planted on public rights of way in the neighborhood.

If your house has land between the sidewalk and the street or abuts on other public property and you would like a tree on that land, here's your chance. Both trees and planting are free. However, residents must bear the cost of removing any dead stumps that would interfere with the planting.

Three types of trees will be available: red maples, sugar maples, and pin oaks. All are well suited for this area and will mature in about 20 years. Three inches in diameter, they are worth \$75 if bought at a commercial nursery.

Call as soon as possible since trees must be planted before winter and since the number available is limited.
