### ***City funds Tyler Park improvements***

Thanks to the Board of Aldermen, especially Tom Owen and Steve Magre, the Metro Parks Department has received \$50,000 designated for improvements to Tyler Park. A portion of the funds will be used to remove dead trees and limbs, and to prune healthy specimens so that desirable trees can prosper. We're working closely with Metro Parks to ensure that the natural beauty of Tyler Park is maintained and that tree trimming is done by qualified arborists.

*A similar project last year in Central Park had very positive results. Once the project in Tyler Park is completed, replacement of trees which have been lost to disease, storms and summer drought can begin.*
