TPNA MEMBERSHIP

TPNA ANNUAL FALL FESTIVAL

The 1997 TPNA Fall Festival is scheduled for Sunday, September 7, 1997, from 2PM until dark. Once again raffle tickets will be sold for prizes from local merchants, but this year a Grand Prize of \$300 will also be awarded.
