## TPNA ANNUAL EASTER EGG HUNT

The annual TPNA Easter Egg Hunt will be held on Saturday, April 11, at 10 AM on the east (tennis court) side of the park. Hundreds of eggs will be hidden. Children under 12 may participate. Egg hunters will be divided into three different age groups: (1) 3 years and under; (2) ages 4 to 8; (3) ages 9 to 11. Each group will have a separate area. Parents are allowed to assist the youngest group only. All children must bring their own baskets or bags. There will be one egg in each of the three groups containing a non-candy item, which may be redeemed for a special prize. Only a heavy rain will cause the event to be canceled. Don't be late, because once the signal is given to begin the hunt, all the eggs are usually found within ten minutes.

Volunteers are needed the day of the Easter Egg Hunt between 8:15 and 9:30 AM to help clean up the park a bit and to assist in the hiding of the eggs. This would be an ideal way for the neighborhood teens to help out. If you can be of assistance, please call Mary Tomes (459-6220) or Jack Pittenger (451-3731).

Everyone in the Tyler Park area is asked not to use the east side of the park for walking dogs for the entire week before the Easter Egg Hunt, or to clean up after them if you do. We want the children to find Easter eggs, not 'doggy surprise'!

Earlier this year the TPNA Board of directors provided a list of suggested improvements for Tyler Park to a representative of the Board of Aldermen.

Realizing that there are limited funds available, the Board attempted to prioritize the requests. Due to adverse weather lately, not much has been accomplished yet, but we hope to see some results as time passes and the weather improves.

Another long time resident of the Tyler Park neighborhood, as well as member and past president of the TPNA Board of Directors, is Dr. Steve Henry. Currently a running for the U.S. Senate, Dr. Henry is presently Kentucky's Lieutenant Governor, and prior to that was a Jefferson county Commissioner.

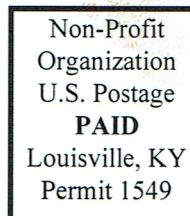
