TPNA ANNUAL EASTER EGG HUNT

The annual TPNA Easter Egg Hunt will be on Saturday, April 3, at 10 AM on the east (tennis court) side of the park. Children up to 11 years old may participate. The park will be divided into three sections for the three different age groups: preschool up through age 5; ages 6-7-8; ages 9-10-11. Parents may accompany pre-schoolers, but the child is to actually pick up the eggs. Each child must bring a basket or other container to collect eggs. There will be one prize egg for each group; all eggs will need to be opened to discover the winner. There will be a container for the deposit of the plastic eggs for those willing to recycle them. These eggs will be used again in future years.

For everyone to be on time, it's suggested that arrival at the starting area be at 9:45 AM. The hunt is usually over in ten minutes. The Easter Egg Hunt will be held regardless of temperature, even if there is a light rain. In case of a heavy rain the event will be rescheduled the same day at 4 PM

For those people who normally walk their dogs in the park, you are asked to use the west (lower) section of the park between now and April 3, and to clean up after them if you do. Prior to the event, volunteers will be asked to walk over the entire area where eggs are to be hidden to remove all dog waste and debris such as broken glass that might be a danger to children. Volunteers are needed for this task as well as to assist in hiding the eggs. Please report to the park at 8:30 AM if you can help.
