TPNA Annual Easter Egg Hunt

The annual TPNA Easter Egg Hunt will be held on Saturday April 22 at 10 AM on the east or upper side of Tyler Park. Children up to 11 years old may participate. This year, with Easter three weeks later than in 1999, hopes are that it will be drier and warmer than last year when cold rains came after all the eggs had been hidden.

With a growing number of very young children there will be four separate groups this year rather than just three. The youngest will be divided into two groups, with 1, 2, and 3 year-olds **inside** the fence of the tot lot, and 4 to 5 year-olds searching the area **outside** the tot lot. Ages 6, 7, and 8 will be in their usual area east of the tennis courts, and ages 9 to 11 will need to climb the hill once more.

About 2000 eggs will be hidden. Parents may accompany the 1, 2 and 3 year-olds, but please have each child pick up his/her own eggs. Each child must bring a basket or other container in which to collect the eggs.

There will be one prize egg for each age group; all eggs must be opened to discover the winning eggs. If you would like to recycle the plastic eggs for use again next year, please empty the eggs and deposit them in the large container near the bridge tunnel. Last year more than 800 eggs were recycled and will be used again this year.

It is important for everyone to be on time. However, there is no advantage in arriving before 9:45 AM. Children become impatient if they have to wait very long. Once the signal is given, all eggs will be found within 15 minutes. There will be a few extra eggs available for any that fail to find one. Check at the table near the water fountain.

Preparation for Easter Egg Hunt

If you normally walk your dog in the park, please use the west or lower section of the park between now and April 22. Volunteers will comb the area where eggs will be hidden to remove dog waste and other debris such as broken glass that would be hazardous to children. If you would like to help clean up and hide eggs (adults and teen-agers invited) please report to the park at 8:30 AM on April 22.
