TPNA Annual Easter Egg Hunt

The annual TPNA Easter Egg Hunt will be held on Saturday April 14 at 10 AM on the east or upper side of Tyler Park. Children up to 11 years old may participate.

Participants will be divided into four different age groups. The youngest will be divided into two groups, with 1, 2, and 3 year-olds **inside** the fence of the tot lot, and 4 to 5 year-olds searching the area **outside** the tot lot. Ages 6, 7, and 8 will have the area **east** of the tennis courts, and ages 9 to 11 will hunt for eggs on the hill **south** of the tennis courts up to Edgeland Avenue.

More than 2000 eggs will be hidden. Parents may accompany the 1, 2 and 3 year-olds, but should allow the child to pick up the eggs. Each child must bring a basket or other container in which to collect the eggs. Large filled Easter baskets will be awarded to those children who find the eggs with the special tokens inside. Eggs must be opened to find the winning tokens. If you would like to recycle the plastic eggs for use again next year, please empty the eggs and deposit them in the large container near the bridge tunnel. Last year more than 1000 eggs were recycled; each was cleaned and will be used again this year. However, children may keep the eggs if they wish.

It is important for everyone to be on time. However, there is no advantage in arriving before 9:45 AM. Children become impatient if they have to wait very long. The hunt will start at 10 AM with all groups starting at the same time when the whistle is blown. Usually, once the signal is given all eggs are found within 15 minutes. There will be a few extra eggs available for any that fail to find one, or for those who arrive too late. Check at the table near the water fountain.

Preparation for Easter Egg Hunt

A group of TPNA Board Members and other volunteers will meet in Tyler Park at the site of the Easter Egg Hunt around 8 AM on Saturday April 14. They will comb the area where eggs will be hidden to remove dog waste and other debris such as broken glass that would be hazardous to children. They then hide the 2000 eggs – some to be found easily, some not. If you would like to help clean up and hide eggs (adults and teen-agers invited) please report to the park by 8:30 AM on April 14. If you normally walk your dog in the park, please use the west or lower section of the park between now and April 14. Even though many people do clean up after their dog, many do not.

TPNA Fall Festival – Planning Stage

The 2001 TPNA Fall Festival will be held in Tyler Park on Sunday, September 9. Mark your calendar **now** so you don't forget. Many of the same kinds of entertainment and activities included in recent years will be on the program once again, but the TPNA Board welcomes any new ideas that you may have.
