

# RESIDENTS ATTEND HEARING ON SUNSET EAST LICENSE

About 40 people, including many residents of Tyler Park, attended a hearing on the issuance of a liquor license to Sunset East Tavern, 1318 Bardstown Rd. Alderman Mike Carrell and residents of nearby Windsor Place and Bellwood Ave. spoke against issuing the license, saying there have been more problems since the tavern moved its entrance to the rear of the building. The neighborhood association supports the residents in this matter.
