




HEATING TIPS FROM THE LOUISVILLE AND JEFF-ERSON COUNTY ENERGY MANAGEMENT TASK FORCE

Using gas stoves or ovens for heat is expensive and dangerous.

Do not use fireplace when your furnace is on; heat will flow into the room and be lost up the chimney. Close all doors to the room with the fireplace and lower the thermostat to 50 degrees Fahrenheit. Open window nearest the fireplace about ½ inch.

Do not block registers with furniture,

drapes, or pictures.

Window shades on the south side of the house should be up during the day and down during the night. Shades on the north side should be down both day and night during the winter.

Stuff pillows or rags up the chimney flue to provide extra draft protection.

Showers use less water than bathing in a tub.

7. If extremely cold weather is predicted to last for several days, run water from the faucet closest to your outside water source about the thickness of a pencil to help prevent your pipes from freezing.

Don't forget to weatherize any windows in your basement or attic and any m basement or cellar doors.
