### THE OLD DAYS IN TYLER PARK: AT THE MOVIES

When movies first became popular, Tyler Park residents had to take the streetcar downtown to the Rialto on Fourth Street (which had live stage shows as well as moving pictures). But movie theaters quickly followed people out Bardstown Road. Today the Baxter Theater building still stands as a heating company on Bardstown Road between Highland Avenue and Grinstead Drive. In the old days, there was an outdoor theater across the street. In the summer, you could sit on benches under the stars and watch a movie for 5¢. The Cherokee Theater stood on the corner of Bonnycastle and Bardstown Road where the convenience store is now.

A major event was the opening of the Uptown Theater at the corner of Eastern Parkway and Bardstown Road.

We are told that the first movie shown there was "The Jazz Singer". Young people in Tyler Park thought that the Uptown was great because they could walk there.

### JOGGING TRAILS

Have you wondered what the arrows in the Park are all about? Bill Franck, one of Tyler Park's distance runners, borrowed a surveyor's wheel and measured three courses for joggers, runners, and walkers.

COURSE #1: Yellow arrows, one mile. From the pavillion in the Park counterclockwise around the loop five times.

COURSE #2: Green arrows, one mile. From pavillion to Castlewood and Tyler Park Drive exit, up Tyler Park Drive to Baxter, across bridge to Edenside sidewalk, to Tyler Park Drive, under bridge, counterclockwise around the loop.

COURSE #3: Rose arrows. One and a half miles. From pavillion under bridge, left up steps across Tyler Park Drive to Rosewood, to Bellwood, to Windsor, to Baxter across bridge to Edenside sidewalk, in Park to Tyler Park Drive sidewalk, back under bridge to pool.

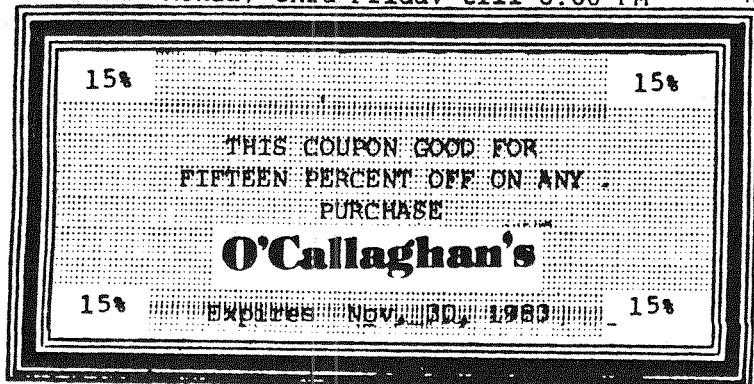
