Each child should bring a basket or bag for collecting the eggs and line up with the appropriate age group until the official start of the hunt is announced. Special prizes to the lucky finders of the “golden eggs” will be awarded.

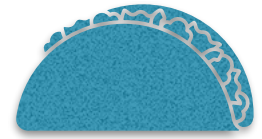
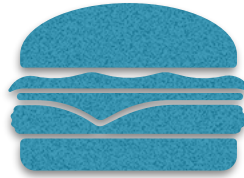

Add Value to Your Home

If the main building on your property in the Tyler Park neighborhood is 100 years old, or older, you can get a TPNA Century Marker like the one pictured below.

Here's the process:

1. Send an email to secretary@tylerpark.org with your name and the address of the property.
2. We will verify your ownership, the location, and the age as shown on the Jefferson County Property Valuation Administrator's website, <https://jeffersonpva.ky.gov/>, and will notify you if your property qualifies.
3. Send a check for \$100 made to TPNA, at our mailbox: PO Box 4452, Louisville, KY 40204, or go to our website, <https://www.tylerpark.org/> and select the green and then complete the CENTURY MARKER dialog.
4. A TPNA volunteer will deliver the Century Marker to you.

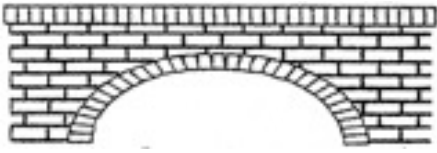
Membership Report
